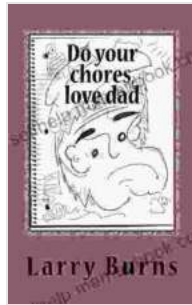

Doing your chores is one way that you can show us that you appreciate everything we do for you.

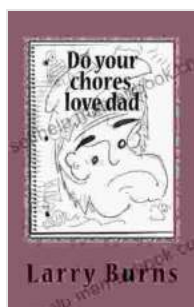
Love and Appreciation

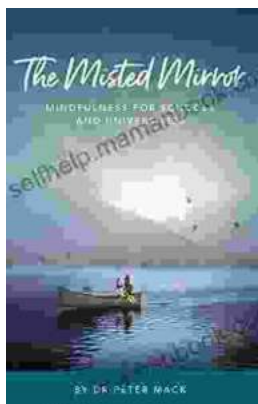

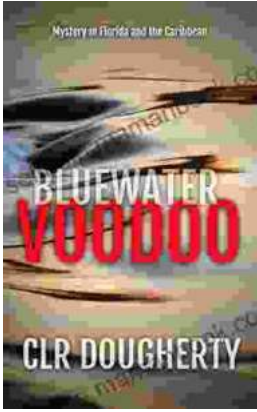
