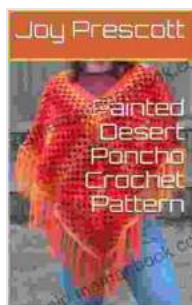

## Materials You'll Need

- Yarn: Worsted weight yarn in a variety of colors (recommended: 6-8 skeins)
- Crochet hook: Size H (5.00mm)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Measuring tape

## Skill Level

This pattern is suitable for intermediate crocheters who are comfortable with basic stitches, including single crochet, double crochet, and treble crochet.

## Pattern Instructions

### Foundation Row

1. Chain 150 (or any desired length for the width of the poncho).

### Body of the Poncho

1. **Row 1:** Single crochet in each stitch across the foundation row.
2. **Row 2:** Chain 1, turn. Double crochet in each stitch across the row.
3. **Row 3:** Chain 1, turn. Treble crochet in each stitch across the row.
4. **Row 4:** Chain 1, turn. Single crochet in each stitch across the row.
5. **Rows 5-25:** Repeat Rows 2-4 to create the desired length for the body of the poncho.

### Armholes

To create the armholes, we will leave a gap in the stitching.

1. **Row 26:** Chain 1, turn. Single crochet in the first 50 stitches, chain 30, skip 30 stitches, single crochet in the remaining stitches across the row.
2. **Row 27:** Chain 1, turn. Single crochet in each stitch across the row, working into the chain-30 space as a single crochet.

3. **Rows 28-40:** Repeat Row 27.

## Neckline

Once the armholes are complete, we will shape the neckline by decreasing stitches.

1. **Row 41:** Chain 1, turn. Single crochet in the first 25 stitches, skip 2 stitches, single crochet in the remaining stitches across the row.
2. **Row 42:** Chain 1, turn. Single crochet in each stitch across the row.
3. **Rows 43-50:** Repeat Row 42.

## Finishing

1. Fasten off the yarn and weave in any loose ends.
2. Block the poncho by gently stretching it and pinning it to a flat surface. Allow it to dry completely.

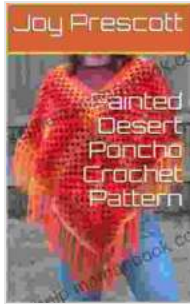

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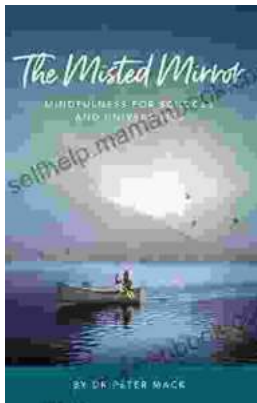
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
