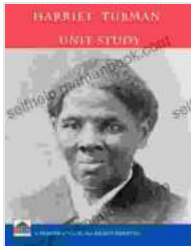

Preschoolers

Elementary School

* **Read** the book "Harriet Tubman: Freedom Fighter" by Ann McGovern. * **Write** a report on Harriet Tubman's life and accomplishments. * **Create** a timeline of Harriet Tubman's life. * **Build** a model of the Underground Railroad. * **Sing** the song "Harriet Tubman" by Woody Guthrie.

Middle School

* **Read** the book "Harriet Tubman: The Road to Freedom" by Catherine Clinton. * **Write** an essay on Harriet Tubman's role in the Underground Railroad. * **Create** a presentation on Harriet Tubman's life and accomplishments. * **Research** the history of slavery in the United States. * **Debate** the issue of slavery and abolitionism.

High School

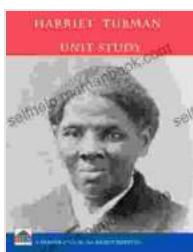

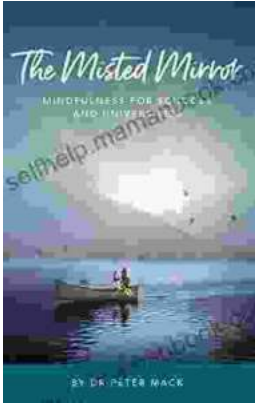


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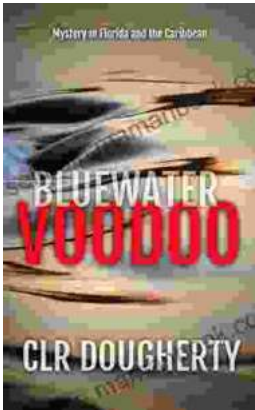
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
